- 1. Do I need previous SAP or IT expertise to be a member of <u>SAP MM course in pune</u>?

 No. SAP MM is primarily functional. A basic comprehension of processes in business can help but the program starts with the basics and progresses to configuration and practice.
- 2. Will I be able to have direct access to SAP Systems?

 Yes, this course will provide live access to servers (ECC and S/4HANA Sandbox) which allows you to perform real-time transactions and configurations.
- 3. How long will the SAP MM course last?

 Typical durations are between 8 and twelve months (part-time) or 4 to 6 months (intensive speed track). The exact duration is dependent on how many students are in the batch and also on the length of the practical labs.
- 4. Are you teaching SAP S/4HANA and Fiori or just ECC?

 Both. The core ECC flow is taught for the foundation of understanding. S/4HANA concepts and Fiori procurement tools are taught to help you prepare for the latest implementations.
